

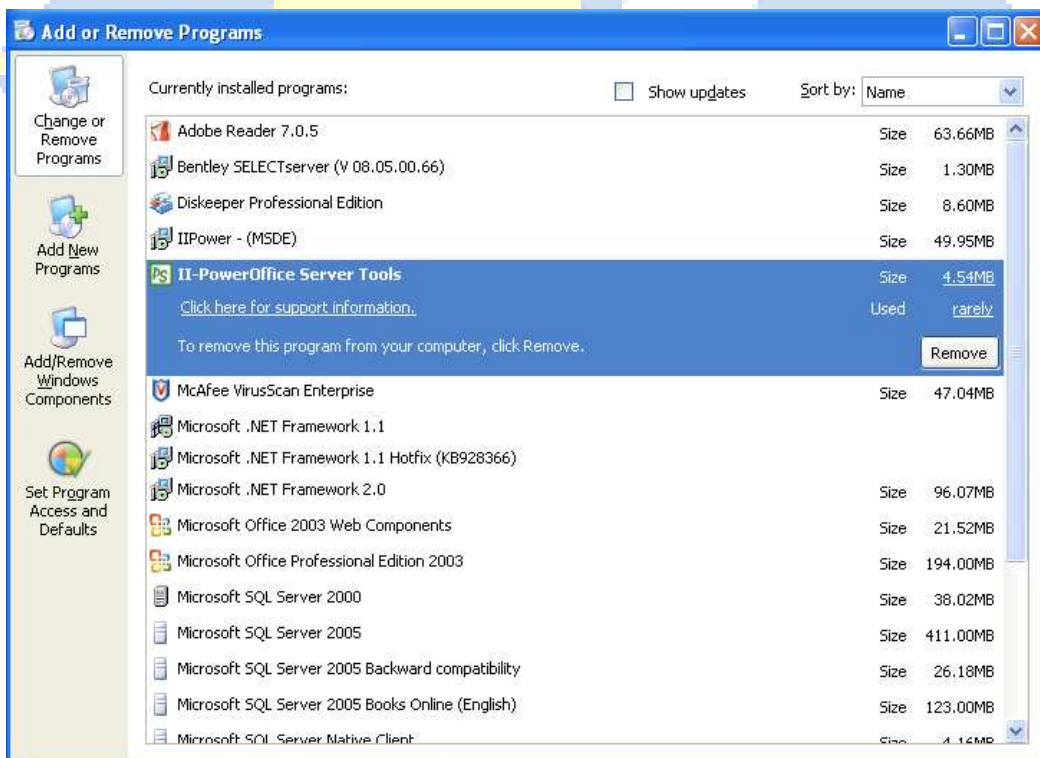
Inspired Interfaces

Upgrading to PowerOffice 11

System Requirements

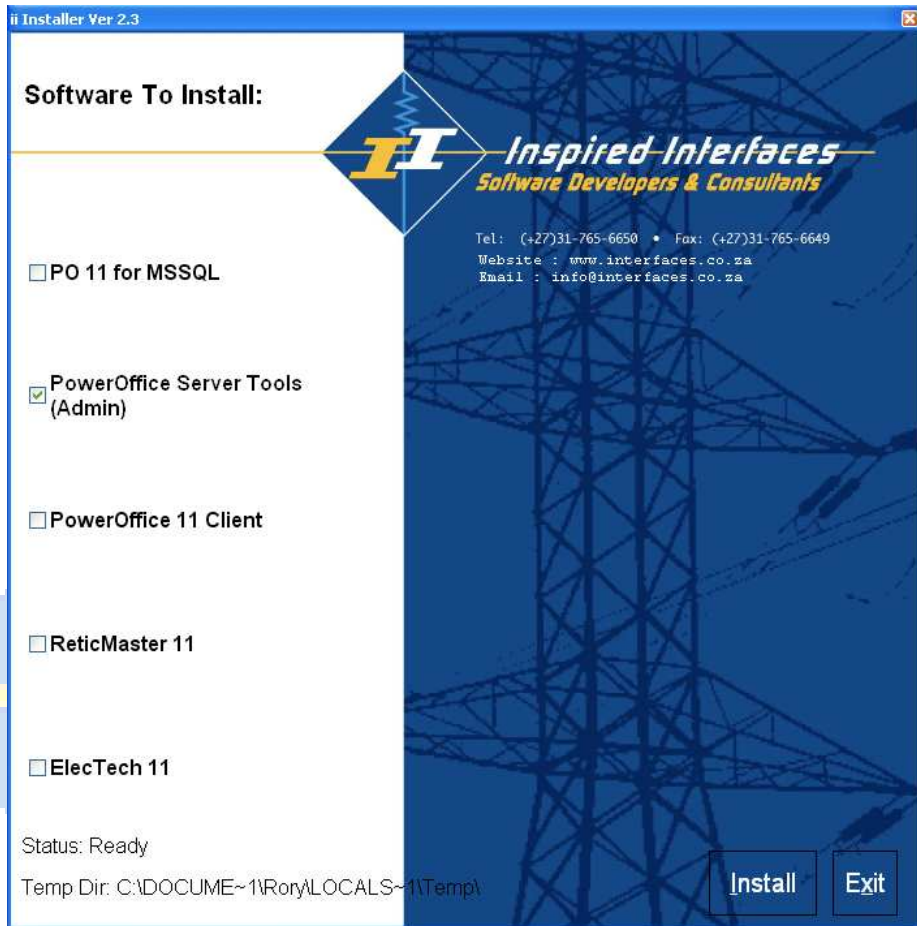
Windows XP	Must have Administration Rights
Windows Vista	Must have Administration Rights and User Account Control switched off.

- The upgrade is done on the machine which is the PowerOffice Server containing the data.
- Before you can upgrade to PO Server Tools 11 the old version has to be removed first.
- Select Windows **Start/All Programs** and **Control Panel**.
- In the Control Panel window select **Add or Remove Programs**.
- Search for **II-PowerOffice Server Tools** and select **Remove**.

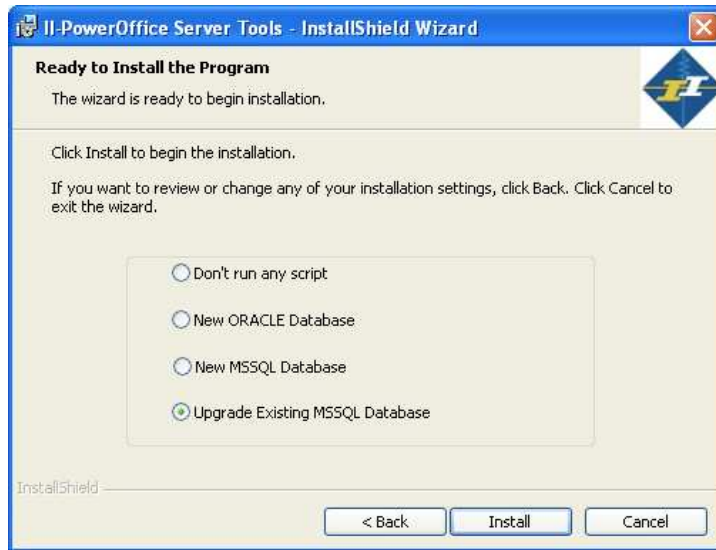


- Select **Yes** if asked **Are you sure you want to remove II-PowerOffice Server Tools from your computer?**

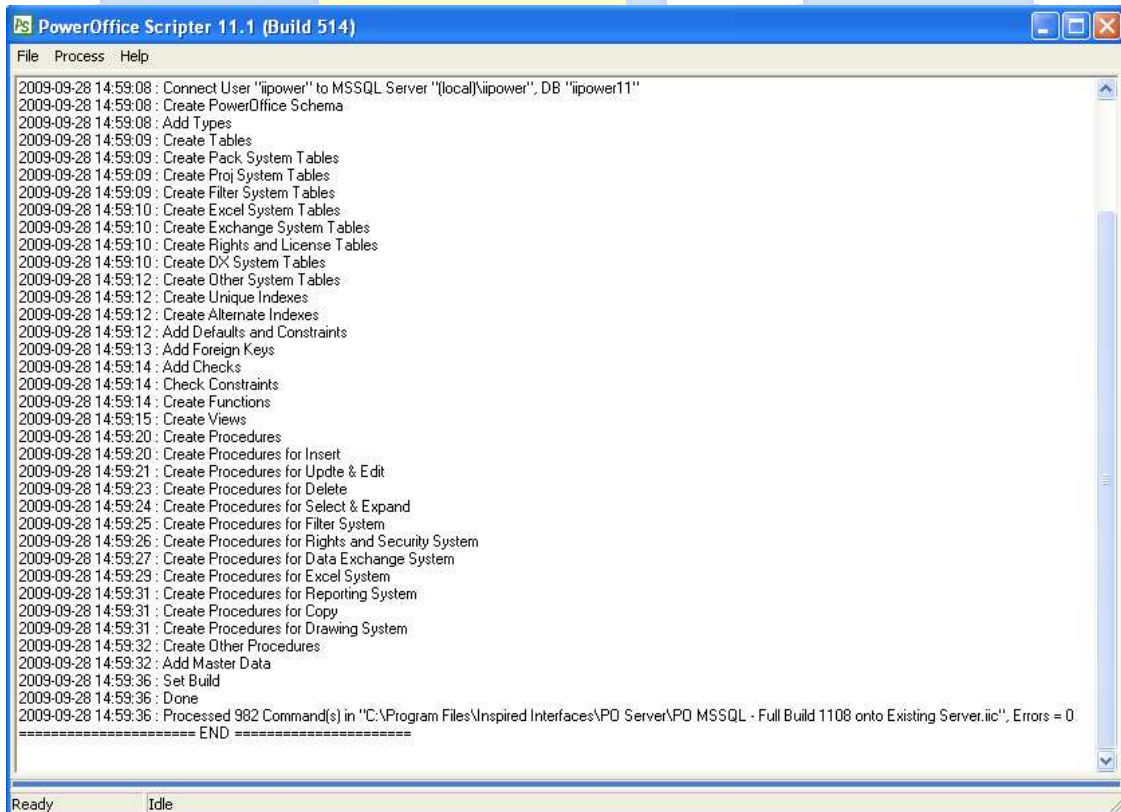
- Once II-PowerOffice Server Tools is removed all applications can be closed and the Inspired Interfaces CD can be inserted, which will open the II Installer window.



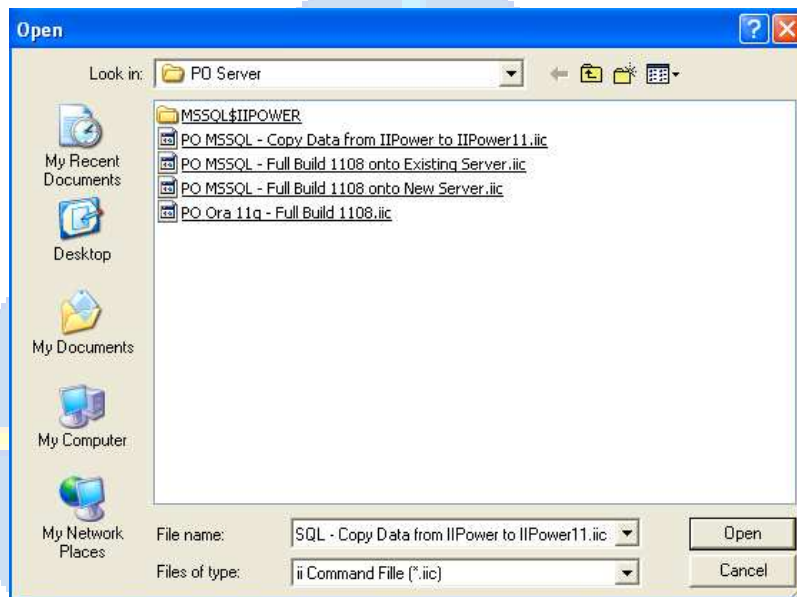
- Select PowerOffice Server Tools (Admin). **Remove ticks for software not wanting to install.**
- Select **Install**.
- The **II-PowerOffice Server Tools – InstallShield Wizard** will open.
- Accept the suggested defaults during installation until the following dialog window is presented.



- Select the radio button ***Upgrade Existing MSSQL Database*** and then ***Install***
- The PowerOffice 11 Scripiter will automatically run, make sure you have 0 errors at the end of installation.



- The PowerOffice Scriptor can be closed and select **Finish** on the Install Wizard dialog window.
- Go to **Start/All Programs/ Inspired Interfaces/ PowerOffice Server Tools** and select **PO Scriptor**. This will open the PowerOffice Scriptor window and a PowerOffice Scriptor Registration window requiring an unlock.
- Send the Serial number to info@interfaces.co.za requesting an unlock to run the PO Scriptor.
- Once an unlock code is received select unlock and insert the unlock code, select **OK**.
- In the PowerOffice Scriptor 11 dialog window select **File/Open** which will open a window with files. Select **PO MSSQL – Copy Data from IIPower to IIPowerII.lic**.



- Back in the PowerOffice Scriptor dialog window select the **Process** Tab and **Process Commands Ctrl+P**. The PowerOffice Scriptor will run, make sure you have 0 errors at completion. Close the PowerOffice Scriptor dialog window.

Now on the Client PC

- You now need to make a copy of your old PowerOffice 2005 file. Right click **Start/Explore/Local Disk (C:)/Program Files/Inspired Interfaces**. Find your PowerOffice folder, right click and select **Copy** and then **Paste** into the Inspired Interfaces folder. Once the PowerOffice folder has finished copying, rename the copied PowerOffice folder to PowerOffice 2005.
- Now uninstall PowerOffice 2005 (Client) in **Add or Remove Programs** in **Control Panel**.
- PowerOffice 11 Client can now be installed. In the ii installer dialog box place a tick in the PowerOffice11 Client tick box, make sure all other ticks are removed. Select **Install**.

- Accept the suggested defaults during installation.
- PowerOffice 11 can now be run for the first time.
- Fill in the relevant details in the PowerOffice Login dialog window:

Login: admin

Password: leave blank

Radio button selected for Microsoft SQL Server

Server Name: Must be your server this machine connects to

Instance: IIPower

Database: IIPower11

- Select **OK** and **I Agree** in the PowerOffice DEMO window.
- PowerOffice 11 will open with a PowerOffice Registration window, requiring a unlock. Send the serial number to info@interface.co.za
- Once a unlock code is received select unlock and insert the unlock code, select **OK**.
- PowerOffice 11 is now ready to be used.
